Applied Learning Challenges (ALC)

Each delegate brings a live business challenge to the programme and during the week applies theories, models, tools and techniques to the challenge. This ensures our Original Thinking gets Applied to your organisational challenges, problems and opportunities.

Learning Trios

Delegates are be placed into groups of three, with people on the programme who face similar issues. Together you support, test and develop solutions to your Applied Learning Challenges. We know that insights come from the other leaders on the programme, not just our world-leading faculty.

Internal Mentors and External Coaching

Each delegate identifies and interacts with an internal mentor from their organisation – helping to bridge the gap between the insights and ideas explored during the programme and the reality of embedding and driving sustainable change when you get back.

You also receive executive coaching to support you through your learning journey, helping you make the transition to the next step in your career as well as translate your plans into action.

Using the Virtual Learning Environment we will share short blogs, videos and readings to get you thinking about the key themes of Leadership, Strategy and Commercial Excellence.


You will complete a comprehensive collection of self-assessment tools to help you understand your leadership DNA and the leadership climate you create.
